OUTDOOR GRILLING

The weather is just right for grilling, a few things to keep in mind:

- Grill position at Pacesetters is 10ft from the soffit hang over of the house.
 Grilling in the garage or on the porch with an overhanging roof is NOT permitted.
- All grills must have a fire proof pan that the grill sits on.
- Check propane tanks and lines for leaks.
- When using a wire brush to clean the grates. Be sure to wipe the grates off before applying food. Debris from the wire brush is left behind on the grates and will transfer to your food.
- Never leave your grill unattended (plan ahead as to what is needed)
- Use long handled grilling tools to give plenty of clearance from heat and flames.
- After grilling turn the gas off at the tank. Do a safety check on the grill so that all fire is extinguished just to be sure.






