WHAT ARE THE THREE E'S?

- Get involved with neighborhood associations, Nextdoor App

EXPOSURE

- Don't be afraid to start conversations in person or online!
- · Be open to meeting people from different backgrounds/cultures
- Pair people with support staff with similar interests/experiences
- · Help people make an effort to stay in touch with people
- · Assist people to invite others to activities/events
- · Be patient! Building a community takes time
